Patient instructions

To get the best out of your test, please follow below instructions:

Specimen labelling and delivery:

- Make sure your full first and last names and date of birth (dd/mm/yy) are clearly written on the specimen container
- Ensure date and time of collection are written on the form.
- Drop of your sample off at the Waikato hospital laboratory reception area, nearest depo or GP/clinician as soon after collection as possible.
- You may refrigerate your sample if you anticipate a delay.

Collection procedure:

- 1. Pass the first portion of urine in the toilet.
- 2. Then pass the second stream of urine into a sterile container this is the Mid-stream urine specimen required.
- 3. Try to fill the container to the 50mL line.
- 4. Screw the lid on tightly.
- 5. Label the specimen container with full name, date of birth, NHI (if known) and date and time of collection.
- 6. Ensure date and time of collection are written on the form.
- 7. Place the specimen into the main pocket of the bag and close the bag.
- 8. Place the request form (obtained from your GP/Clinician) in the outside pocket of the same bag.
- 9. To be delivered to the laboratory promptly or kept in the fridge, until it can be delivered.
