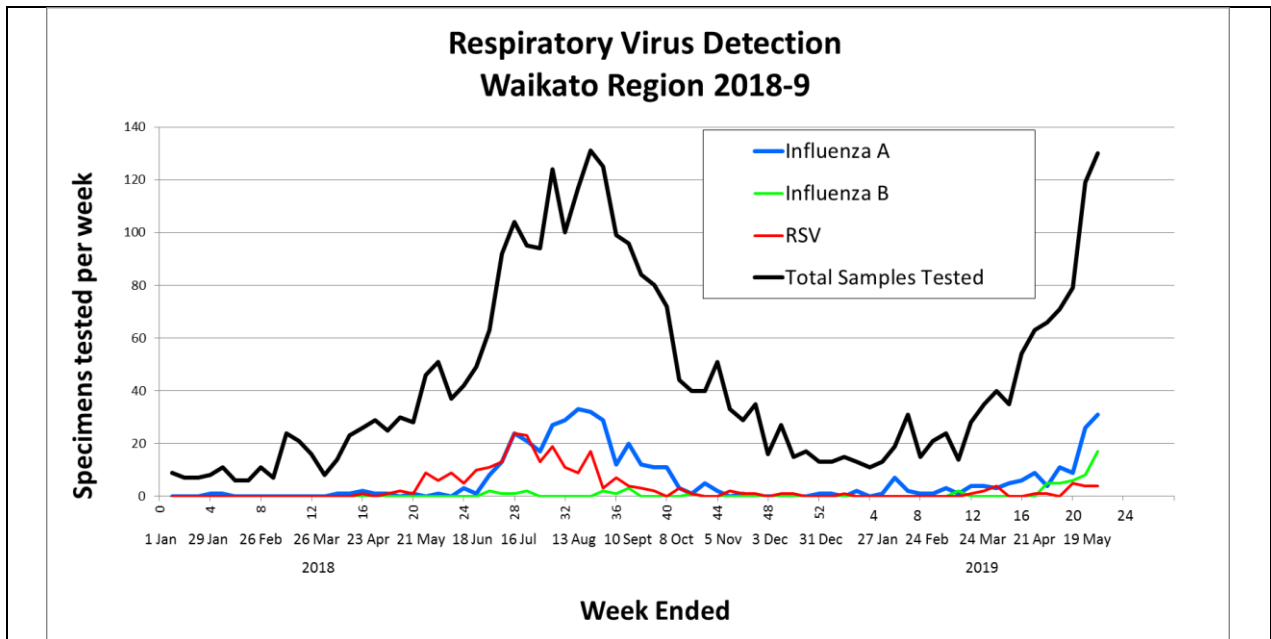


Waikato Respiratory Virus Report

Week to 2 June 2019

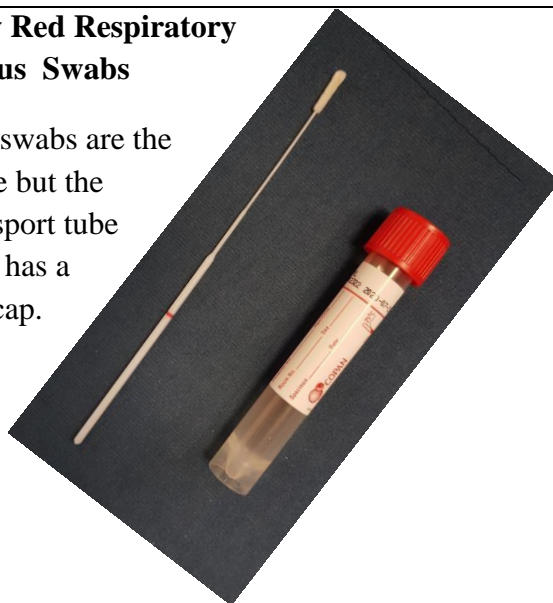
Week 22 2019

Influenza numbers continue to rise and are now comparable to last year's peak. 37% of people tested have either Influenza A and B and would benefit from oseltamivir. Another quarter have one of the "minor" respiratory viruses and RSV hasn't really made an appearance yet.

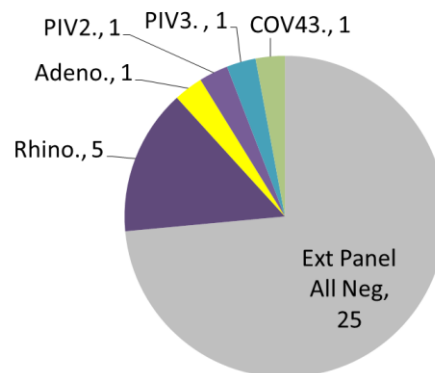


New Red Respiratory Virus Swabs
