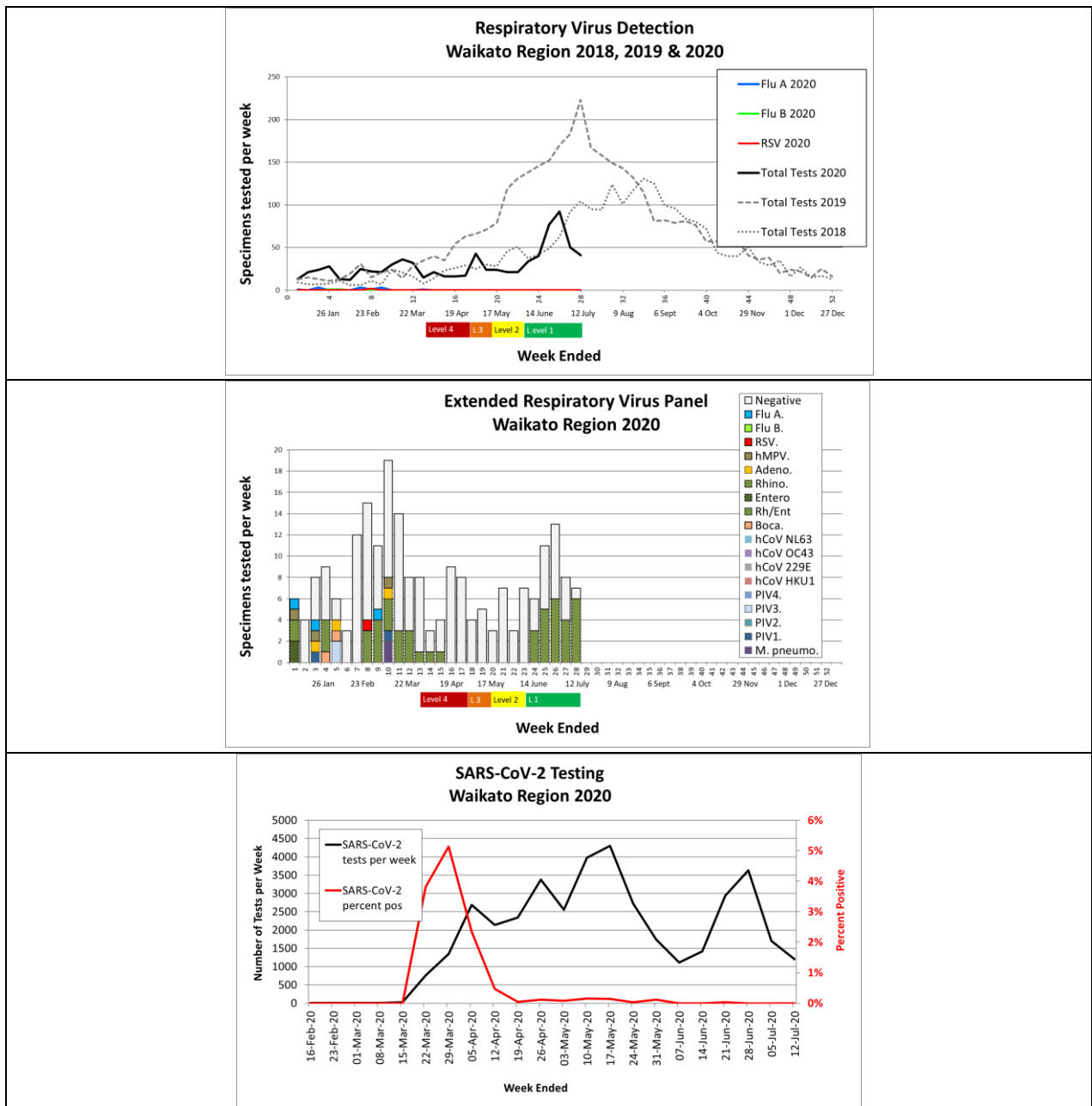


# Waikato Respiratory Virus Report

Week 28 2020

Week to 12 July 2020

Standard respiratory virus specimen numbers have fallen off during the past two weeks, paralleling testing efforts for SARS-CoV-2. No cases have been found among those at the three managed isolation facilities (hotels) in the Waikato. Rhinovirus is circulating and we are finding it in most specimens referred. We have seen severe cases in ICU and outbreaks in institutions. Influenza and RSV have still not arrived.
