

We aren't finding much except SARS-CoV-2 at the moment. Rhinoviruses are present and probably account for most non-COVID respiratory viral illness.

Influenza A H3N2 (in North America and Europe) and B/Victoria (in China) are increasing in the Northern Hemisphere, where it's Spring now. Three cases of each were reported from Australia in February.
