
Waikato Respiratory Virus Report

15 August 2022

The Influenza B seems to have been an isolated case. Influenza A continues to fall away and RSV continues to climb gradually. There is a small amount of Rhino/Enterovirus around and some Coronavirus OC43. Only one case of metapneumovirus was found last week and adenoviruses and parainfluenzaviruses have not been seen for a few weeks.
