
## Waikato Respiratory Virus Report

5 Sept 2022

RSV continues at a high level, typical of pre-COVID seasons. The Influenza B has not been seen again since the one detection. Than you to that patient and any others who may have had it, for having taken precautions and preventing it taking hold in the Waikato. Influenza A has also disappeared. We could only test a limited number of samples by extended panel last week due to a supply problem. SARS-CoV-2 detections at Waikato Hospital have declined significantly over the past month (data not shown).
