Glucose/Lactose Hydrogen Breath test;

Positive is defined as a rise of >20ppm breath hydrogen from baseline.

Lactulose Hydrogen Breath test;

The following supports bacterial overgrowth:

An early rise (at or before 90 minutes) >12ppm rise from baseline.

A double peak >12ppm rise from baseline.

An early rise that persists >12ppm rise from baseline.

A late rise indicates patient is a hydrogen producer.
